**Objective of Activity: Checking the purity of water and Spreading awareness.**

- **Agenda of Activity**

1. Spreading awareness regarding water preservation and consumption.
2. Checking the purity of different water bodies in the selected area.
3. Collecting information from the local public regarding water usage and supply.

- **Execution:-**

A rally was conducted by the students of the Oswal Degree College on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2017 to spread the awareness regarding water consumption and water salvation. The students returned to the college for a break of fifteen minutes and then the members of NSS went for the water survey in the surrounding areas of Owli Gaon. The water bodies in the area were observed and checked. The level of suitability (purification) of water was as follows:

- 2.) Talao Two at Awli Gaon -8.0 D. O. A
- 3.) Water from the Pump in the village-11.0 D. O. A

The students went to the nearby houses in village for collecting information related to problems of water resources during survey students identify that many people suffering from polluted water and shortage of water supply. After completion of survey, students returned to the college around one o'clock in the afternoon.

1. Students identified the problems of water facing by community.
2. Students suggested some majors to preserve water.
3. The rally and survey had been successfully conducted.
