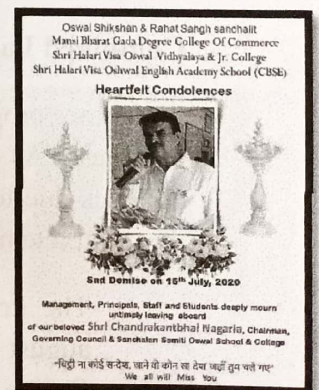

Introduction:

Due to COVID 19 Pandemic situation and its spread across India, the Physical college functioning was suspended from 16th March 2020. The college functioning shifted to online through zoom meeting, emails, google sheet, google docs, software s, online classroom, fees payment, admission process etc The Administrative work started in the month of June, 2020.

The sad part of starting of the year was untimely demise of our beloved Chairman Shri Chandrakant Nagaria due to Covid. With the homage to the great soul the academic year began with several challenges.

In the Process of Covid Pandemic phase **Unlock 3**, colleges could be started virtually and online lectures were to be conducted. As per the Mumbai University circular UG/01 of 2020-2021 dated 2nd August, 2020 stating online lectures to be started from 7th August for second- and third-year students, It was



decided to conduct orientation differently for all classes to prepare the mindset, boost energy and online lectures thereafter.

The regular online lectures were conducted on google meet from 7th Aug. to 8th Dec. 2020 for first term and second term lectures were conducted from 2nd January to 20th March, 2021 Examination and All other extra and co-curricular activities were also conducted online.

Attendance process:

As the online lectures happened throughout the year 2020-21, online attendance mechanism was adopted. The subject wise faculties were maintaining students attendance in excel sheet and at the end of the month, the attendance committee prepared the consolidated monthly attendance record of each class from Aug, 2020 to Jan. 2021. As per the Circular issued by Govt. of Maharashtra, the government had decided to drop the 75% attendance norm for college students due to pandemic situation and availability of poor internet connection in remote areas.

This time parents were made to understand to take the responsibility for the attendance of their wards. Hence sensitively and with flexibility the monthly attendance report of students were made and posted in classwise whatsapp group and sent individually through emails every month. This was to ensure that students must not become casual in attitude taking advantage of the situation, while understanding their practical issues.

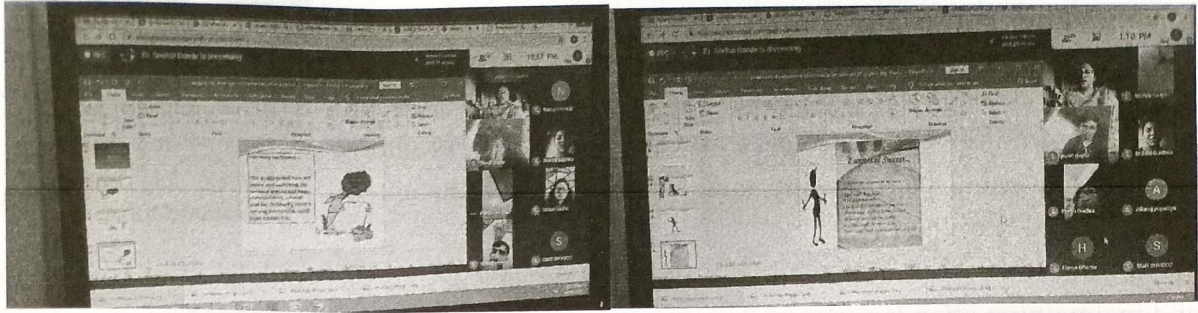
Combined Parents Meeting & Students meet:

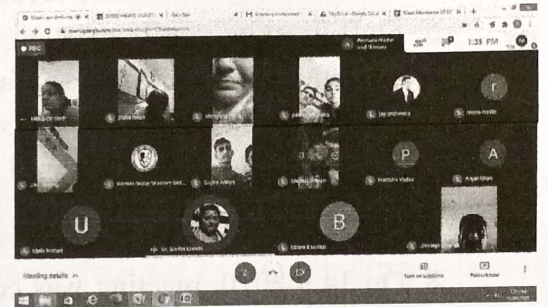
prospective. She also explained the concept of attitude and personality development with illustrations.

4. Defaulter attendance students parents meeting was conducted on 26th November, 2020



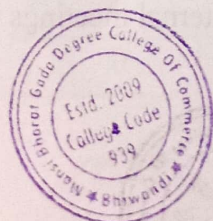
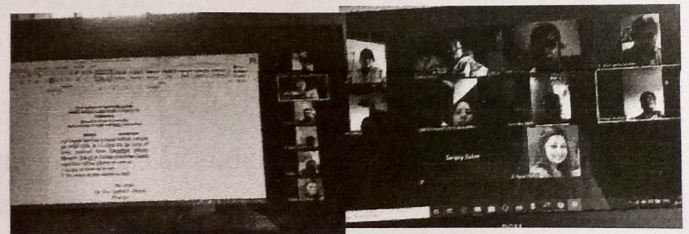
Staff Meetings:

The Permanent staff members meeting was conducted by the Principal on 24.5.2020 to discuss the college closure notice received from Management member and three months pending salary issue. Unanimously it was decided not to allow the closure as a lot of hard work has been put up for the growth development and NAAC certification along with other milestone achievements. Regarding salary and College closure matter Principal informed that she will write both the matters to higher body of the Trust and ensure that all things can be brought in right order.



Due to Pandemic Cost cutting approach as per the instructions of the Secretary, GC the college mostly had to function with visiting faculties. Therefore, every Saturday 3-4pm grooming sessions of new/visiting faculties were conducted by Principal to groom, strategies and take follow up of the online conduct of lecture sessions.

1. 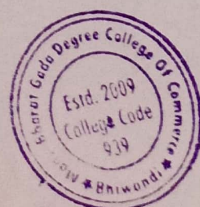


13. On 31.12.2020, Staff Meeting was conducted physically in the college for the follow up of work assigned, Research work updates and to ensure smooth conduct of second term.

As per the circular issued by the University on 9.5.2020 regarding FY/SY promotion, all the students appearing in sem II and IV will be declared as passed and promoted to next class.

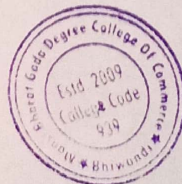

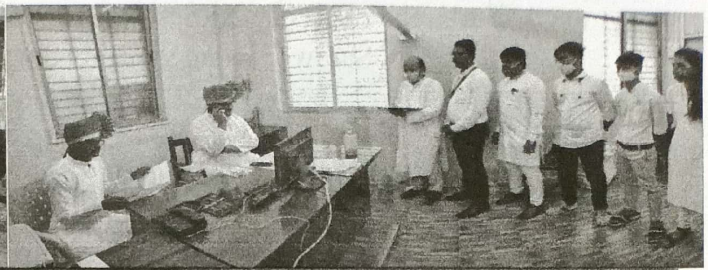
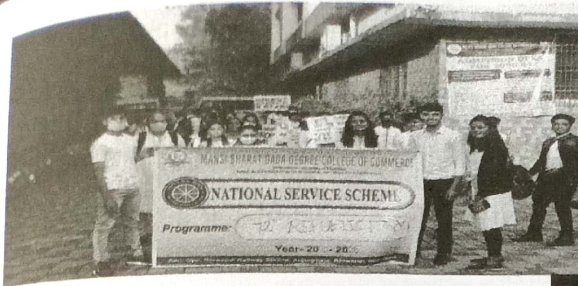
EXTENTION ACTIVITES:

As per the present policies of higher education, NAAC requirements and New Education Policy 2020 directives every year college ensures to work for tackling the major issues of the society and our college takes initiatives to create New Generation Solution aries to curb water, plastic and health sanitation crisis. All such activities are organized under the NSS Unit.

National Service Scheme Unit (NSS) activities:

1. NSS Orientation of First year students were conducted on 7.11.2020 by & Mr. Shital Talati, Komal Gosrani in presence of Mrs. Pooja Dodhia, as other two faculties were new to the college.
2. On 13th Dec. 2020, NSS orientation meeting was held, Area co-ordinator Mr. Deepak Ponkse oriented students on google meet. NSS meeting was Organized by Mr Talathi and Komal Gosrani and a report of same was submitted.
3. On 26th January, 2021, Walkathon Kamwari Swachchhata Abhiyan was organized by NSS unit from college to Court naka (Magistrate office). A Memorandum was handed over to Shri Mohan Naladkar, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Bhiwandi Region to help in the revival of the river and other water bodies. Thereafter Jan Poojan was performed with help of Self Help Group Shelar village on kamwari river at Tilak Ghat with Haldi -kumkum and offering saree. The programme was attended by Shelar village Gram Sevak and others. This was mainly done to bring attention of authorities towards the hyacinth grown in the waterbody due to pollution and need to start desiltation of river Kamvari so as to save people from flash floods which may occur during monsoon.

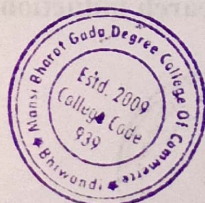




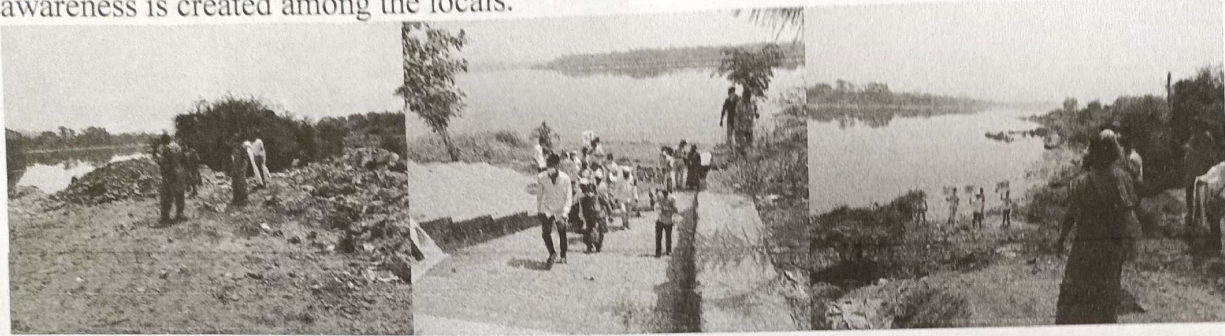
4. The Kamwari river cleaning Movement was held at Tilak Ghat, Nadi Naka on 4th February, 2021. Under the guidance of Jalnayak Dr. Snehal Donde, the NSS students of the college and Aqsa College visited the Tilakghat with Shelar village Officials, Tehsildar and other officers and initiated garbage cleaning.



5. On 11th Feb. 2021, the Dr. Snehal Donde along with staff and NSS volunteers visited Millat Ghat (Kamwari river bank) at Millat Nagar. NSS Volunteers and Staff of Bhiwandi Corporation Health Dept. conducted cleaning drive and with support from New commissioner a JCB machine for cleaning the river was arranged. The NSS volunteers conducted rally from Tilak Ghat to Millat Ghat creating awareness regarding water conservation.



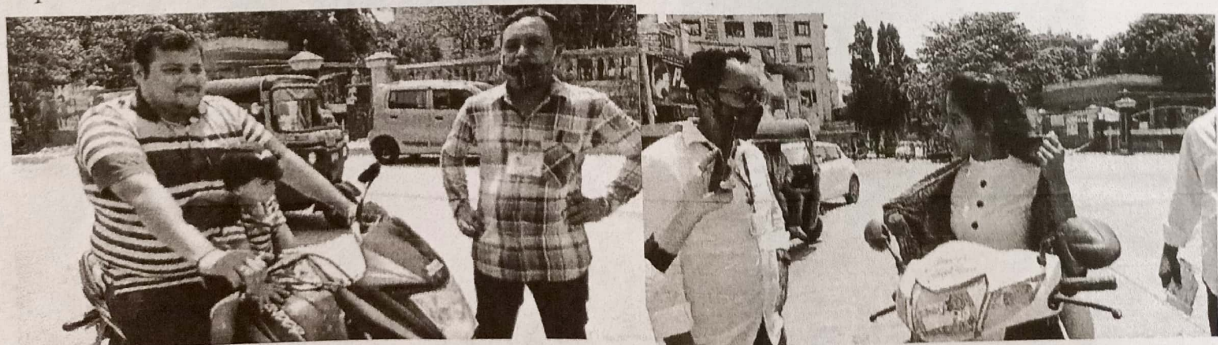
6. On 22nd March, 2021 The NSS volunteers along with Saranayak visited the Ulhas River at Sarawli village, Bhiwandi and performed Nadi Darshan at Ulhas river. They observed the River pollution effluents released directly by Textile & Milk Unit and Paper mill MIDC area. The discharge in the river thereby polluted the river water soil and vegetation beyond imagination. They found three-four location of releasing of polluted water into river without treatment. The Jal Darshan was done with the help of local activist Rahul Mukadam. Students pledged that they will take the ownership to correct the pollution issues and ensure that more awareness is created among the locals.

8. Mask lagao campaign was organized on 1st April, 2021 in collaboration with Bhiwandi Corporation Health Dept where students visited eight strategic places of Bhiwandi. Along with the BNCMC officials Students taught public the right way to wear mask and created the Covid-19 pandemic safety drive. BNCMC officials charged public penalty for not wearing mask and explained the importance of mask in this pandemic situation.

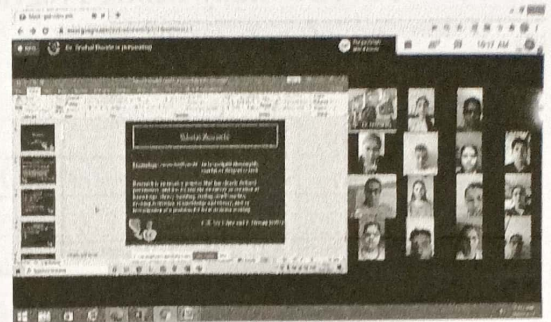


Research Advisory Committee/ Special initiative

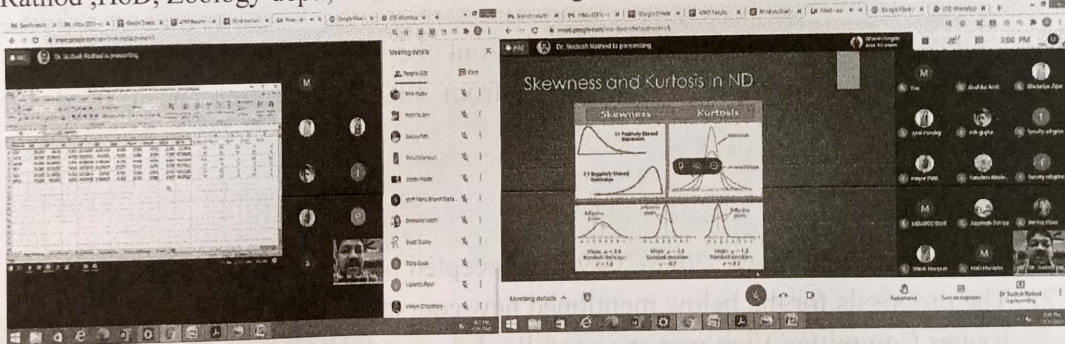


1. On 3.9.2020 & 11.10.2020, staff meeting was conducted by Principal to orient faculties about research aspect in teaching learning process and project based learning.

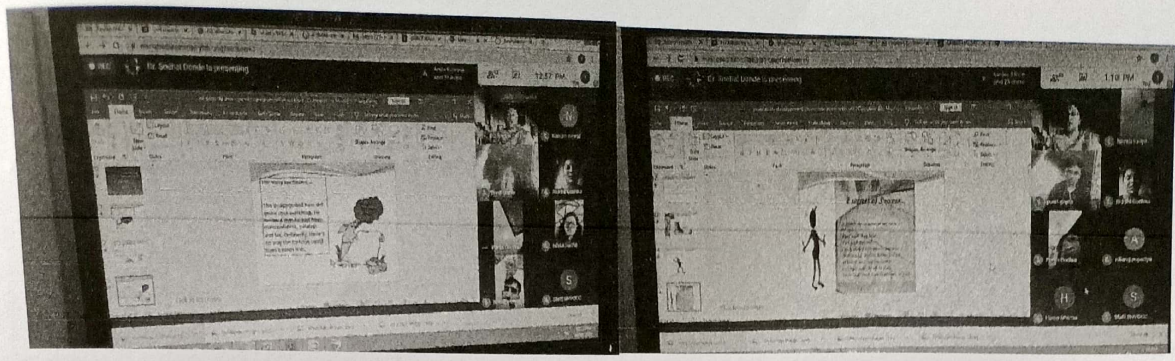
Combined Parents Meeting & Students meet:

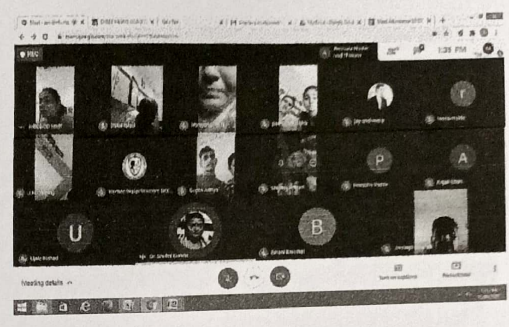

- 4. Defaulter attendance students parents meeting was conducted on 26th November, 2020



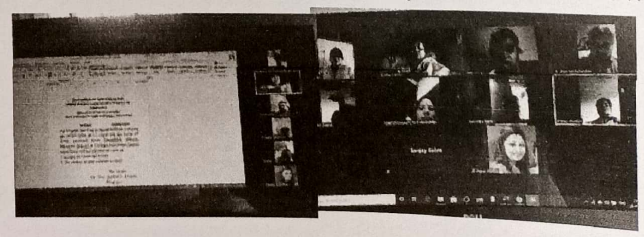
Staff Meetings:
