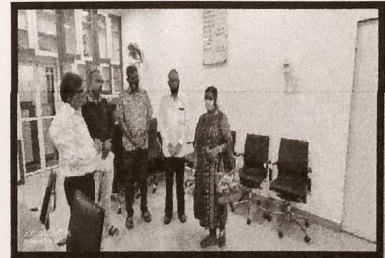

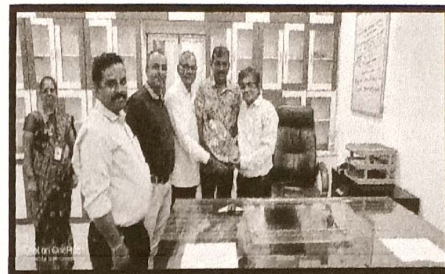
1. INTRODUCTION

This year began with the change in Leadership i.e. change in principal as the five-year tenure of Dr. Snehal Donde came to an end on 12th June 2021,

Who handed over the chair of responsibility to Mr. Mitesh. M. Gosrani. This is the second inning as principal. Initially, he had faced challenges as only 5 to 6 days were available for him to recruit staff and embrace students to college. But college had witnessed his explicit leadership and everlasting vision within a few days.



As the Covid-19 Wave prolonged, for the good sake of students, the college opened the way for online education on 18th June 2021, as per the circular provided by Mumbai University for 2021-22. So, the college started functioning by launching online lectures for S.Y. and T.Y. students.



This technological expansion was just the beginning; the golden era for the college began with permission for Four new additional courses on board. The college is now the home not only for Second and Third year BCOM and BAF students but also for FYBCOM, FYBAF, FYBSC, FYBBI, FYBMS, and MCOM students.

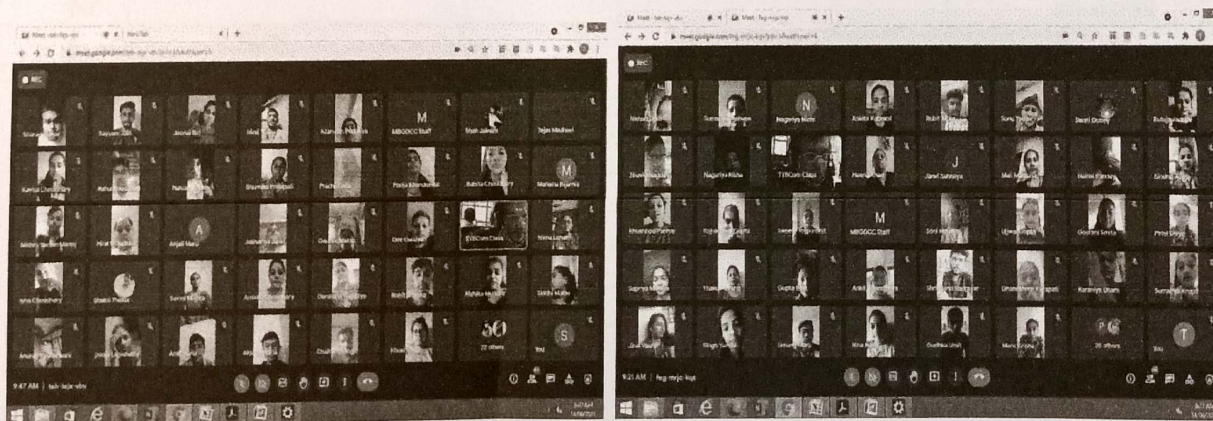

Notices were issued to faculties for question paper submission, assessment and mark sheet submission. Supervision charts were prepared and displayed on notice board.

Examination Related Meeting:

1. The Exam related meeting was convened by Principal on 11th Oct.2021 in Principal's Office to orient faculties for preparation of internal & External examination. The examinations for 1st Term to be conducted online in MCQ pattern. So the faculties were instructed to prepare question bank of MCQ for respective subjects including ATKT examination (Sem I to VI) and submit to Examination committee. It was decided that the Internal evaluation to be done by collecting assignments, class test and overall behavior of the students.

2. The Exam related meeting was convened by the Principal on 19th March, 2022 in Principal's office to discuss the internal examination to be conducted offline in 2nd term. It was decided to conduct mock/prelims for BCom students as a part of Internal Evaluation. The faculties were instructed to prepare and submit Questions papers in 2 sets as per University paper



pattern till 25.03.2022. The block wise allocation and supervision pattern was shared. The teachers were instructed to do strict invigilation during examination.

3. The Exam related meeting was arranged on 1st April, 2022 in Principal's office to discuss and decide the paper pattern of Sem II examinations as it will be conducted offline. The FY faculties were oriented by Principal regarding question bank and Question paper preparation. They were instructed to prepare and submit question paper. The other arrangements for offline examination was discussed and instruction were issued to respective faculties.

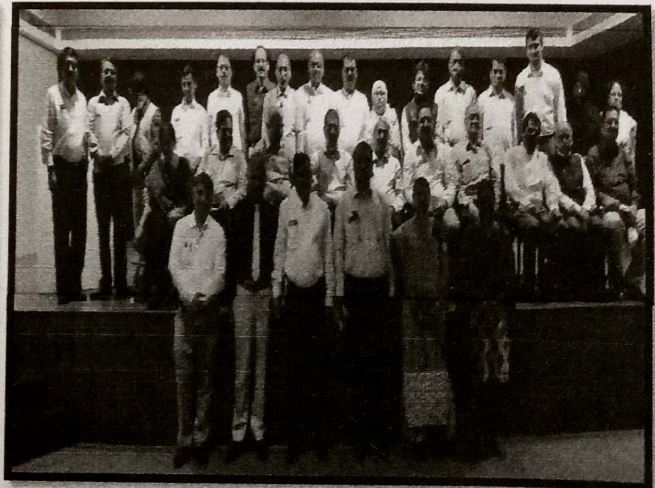


8. ATTENDANCE PROCESS

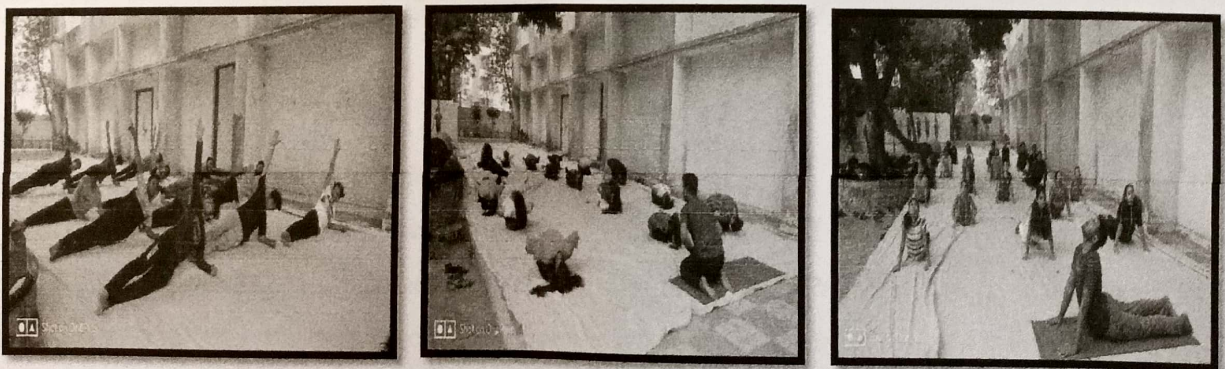
1. INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

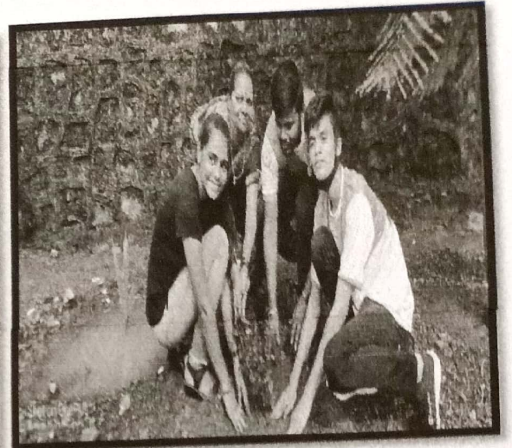
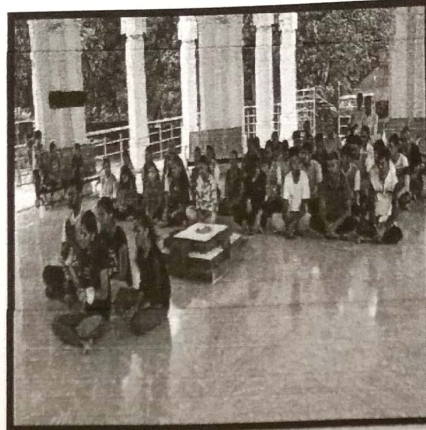
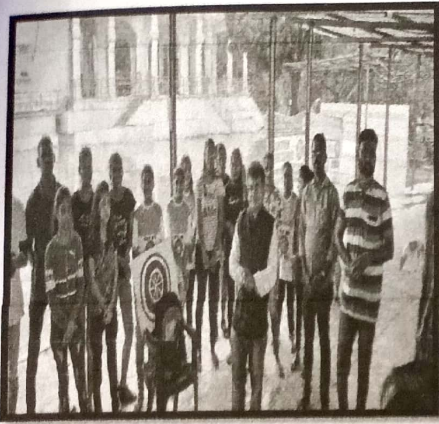
2. Yoga week:

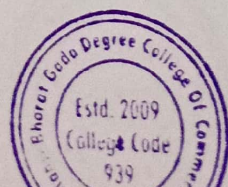
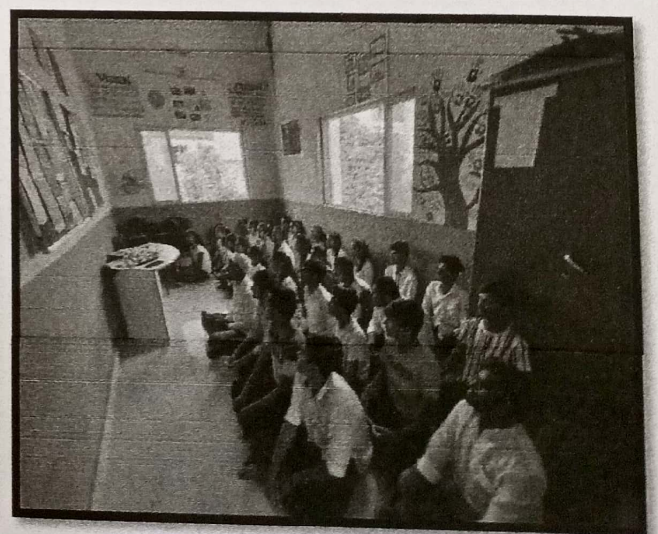
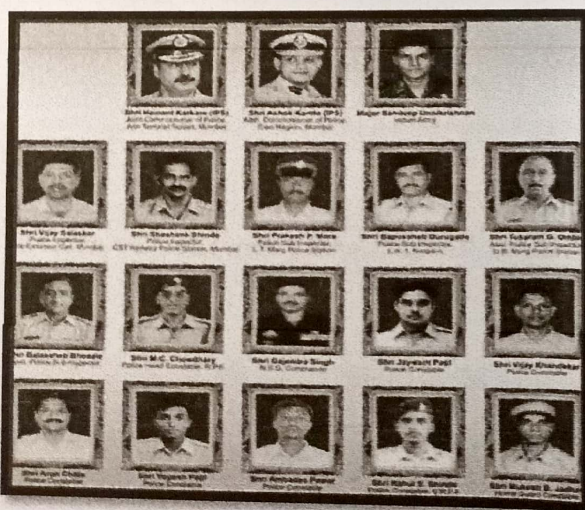
8. NSS Orientation:

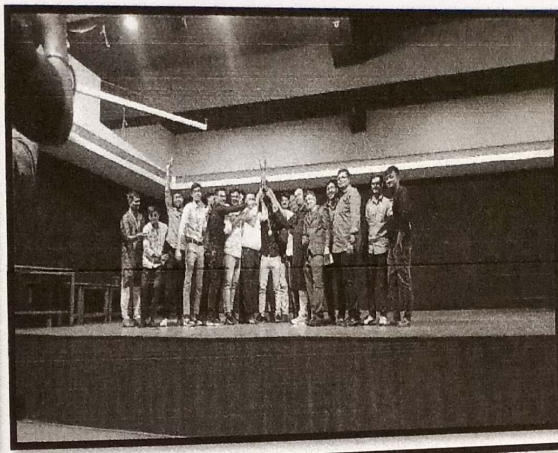
There is equal role of students as of teachers in developing respectful image of a college. Our students proudly represented our college on following grounds.

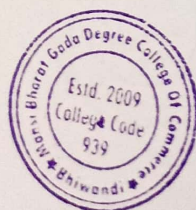


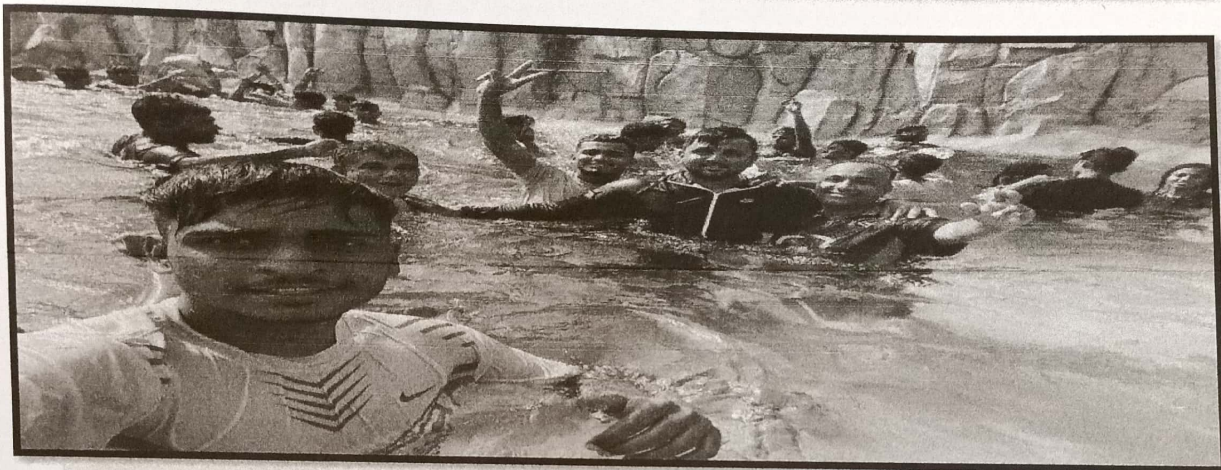
16. STAFF MEETING
