## Report of Parents Meeting

Name of Meeting: Parents orientation meeting

Objectives: The meeting was conducted for discussing below mentioned particulars:

1. Orientation on benefits of regular attendance
2. New courses initiated by college
3. Participation of students in various activities
4. Meeting of defaulter students' parents with class teacher

Preparation:

Notice of parents Meeting was circulated in all classes for intimation on 22<sup>nd</sup> Sept. 2018 and reminder Text messages were sent on 24<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2018.

Detailed report:

First parents meeting was conducted on 25<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2018 in conference Room. Attendance sheets were circulated among parents. It was started at 11.10 am with orientation of parents by Mr. Yogesh Pawar, IQAC Co-ordinator, He covered the following points:

1. He informed parents about the courses currently conducted by the college and new courses initiated in the academic year 2018-19. He informed that New courses of MCom and MBA of YCMOU and IGNOU are started and appealed parents to encourage their wards to enroll for these course who are graduates. He also informed parents about proposed courses of 2019-20 which are BCom (A&F), BMS, B.A and B.Sc.
2. He described the changes seen in attendance of students and infrastructural development in the college during NAAC accreditation process and further conduct of Dhanak and UDAN festival and conferences and students role of leadership and dealing in conflicting situation in managing the events.
3. He urged parents to allow students to remain in college after lecture hours. Preparation for some activities require devotion of more time by students. In case, confirmation can be obtained by class teachers for their attendance in college after college hours.
4. He further informed the progresses of students achieved by participating inter collegiate and community oriented activities and awards won by students. He invited 3 students to share their experience with parents.

Students of SY and TYBCom explained development in communication skills and personality happened by regularly attending college and participating in activities:

1. Prajapati Chirag of TYBCom explained his experience of participation in various activities and his removal of stage fear as he got the opportunities to speak on stage. He shared his readiness for becoming entrepreneur with his business model plan and given credits to Principal and faculties for their support.
2. Bid Ankita of SYBCom shared her experience of attending AHVAHAN camp at Aurangabad through NSS. She told that development in her personality and ability to attend the camp was only due to the skills he learnt in the college.
3. Kejle Pranjal of SYBCom explained discipline she learnt and got opportunity to participate in various activities and winning of prizes. She also told the concept of dividing students council members in 1:10 ratio where one student council member will take care of 10 students of class and follow up for their attendance, encourage them in activities and resolve their issues. Parents appreciated this concept.

Principal in her speech covered the following points.

1. Principal appreciated the parents efforts in attending the meeting and described the students achievement and college presence at national and international level by getting membership of world water Council (WWC)
2. She appreciated the parents for their support to their ward in participating activities and encouraging them for their overall development. She explained the importance of extra curricular activities and their impact on students as bookish knowledge gained is not sufficient to survive in this competitive world.
3. She informed the work students are doing in water related area by performing street play and presenting posters and conducting rallies. She also shared her experience of meetong Mayor and commissioner of BNCMC on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 and taking water oath with students. The students work during Namami Chandrabhaga, water literacy campaign and meeting with Dr. Rajendra Singh ji was also highlighted by Principal.
4. At the end of the meeting, Principal urged parents to remain connected with college and visit college frequently to get their wards attendance and progress status.

Outcome:

Total 50 parents attended the meeting. They suggested to keep meeting on Friday or Saturday so it can be convenient for them to attend the meeting. Parents also suggested to keep regular meeting of such kind.
